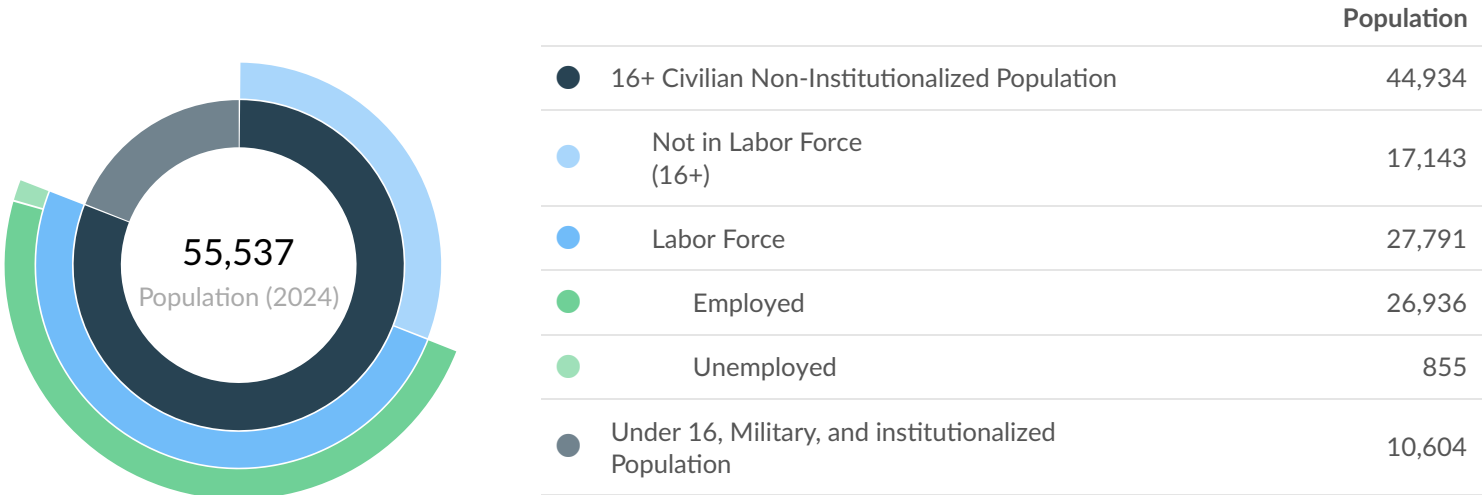
Median household income is **\$3.7K below** the national median household income of \$75.1K.

Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population **increased by 14.0%** since 2018, growing by 6,614. Population is expected to **increase by 13.3%** between 2023 and 2028, adding 7,190.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs **increased by 15.8%** in Burnet County, TX from 17,775 to **20,591**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 4.5% by 11.3%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 59.1% to 60.4% between 2018 and 2023**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **19.7% of Burnet County, TX residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (1.5% below the national average), and **6.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.6% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

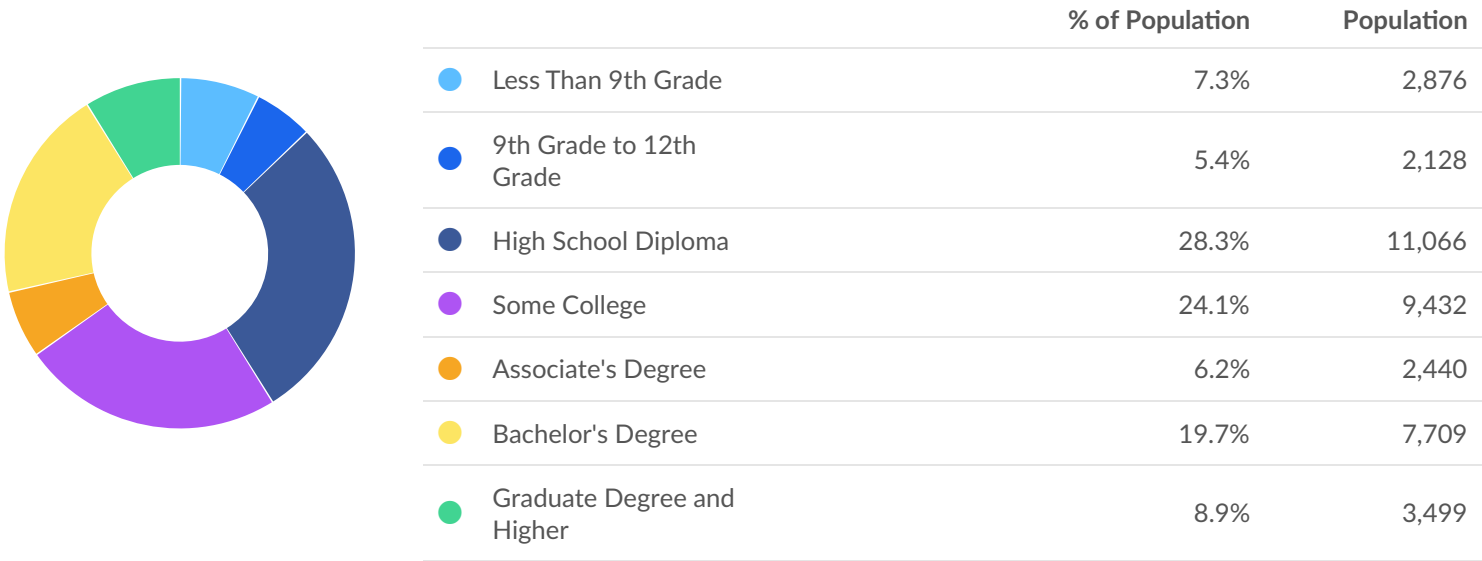

Sep 2024 Labor Force Breakdown



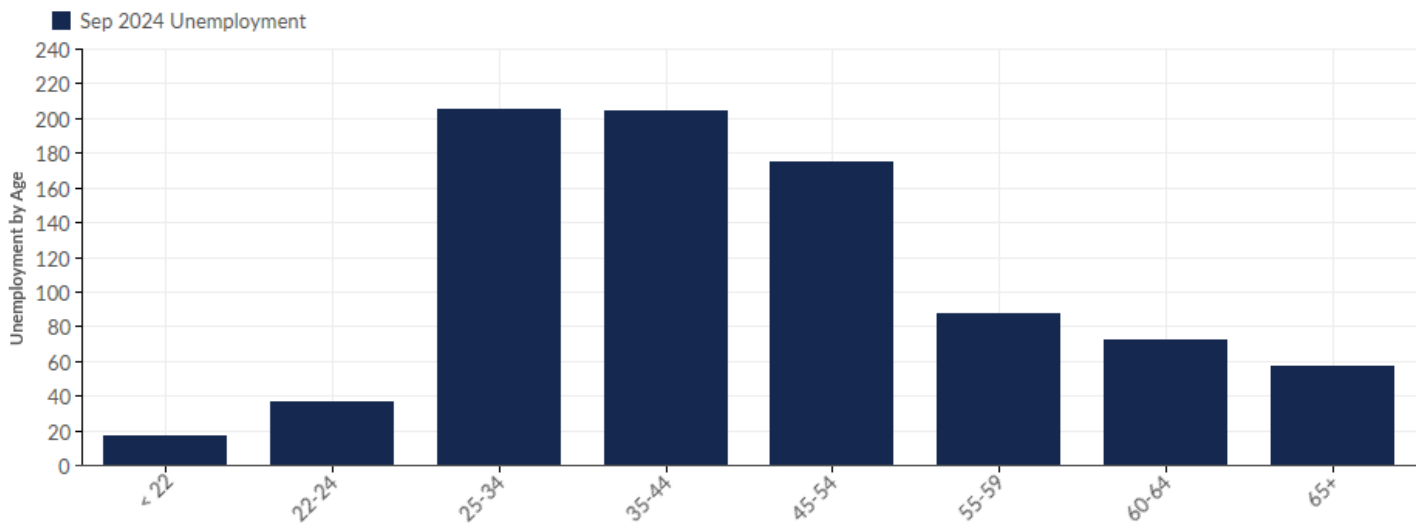
Educational Attainment

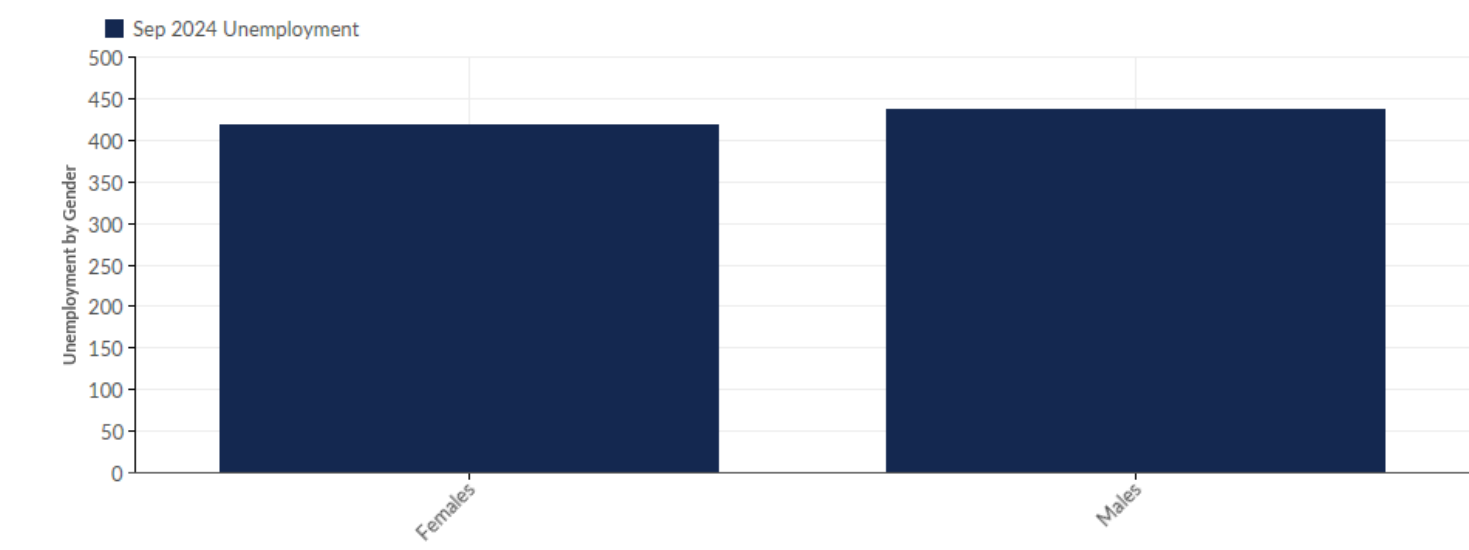

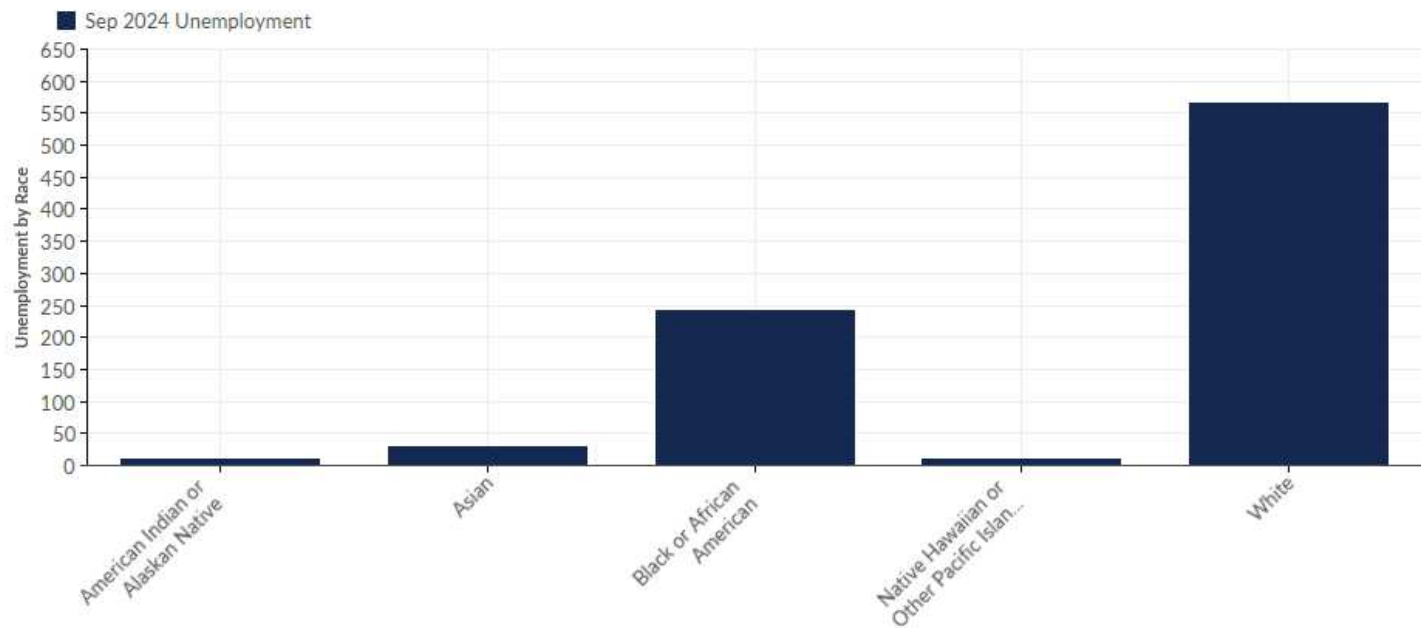

Unemployment by Gender



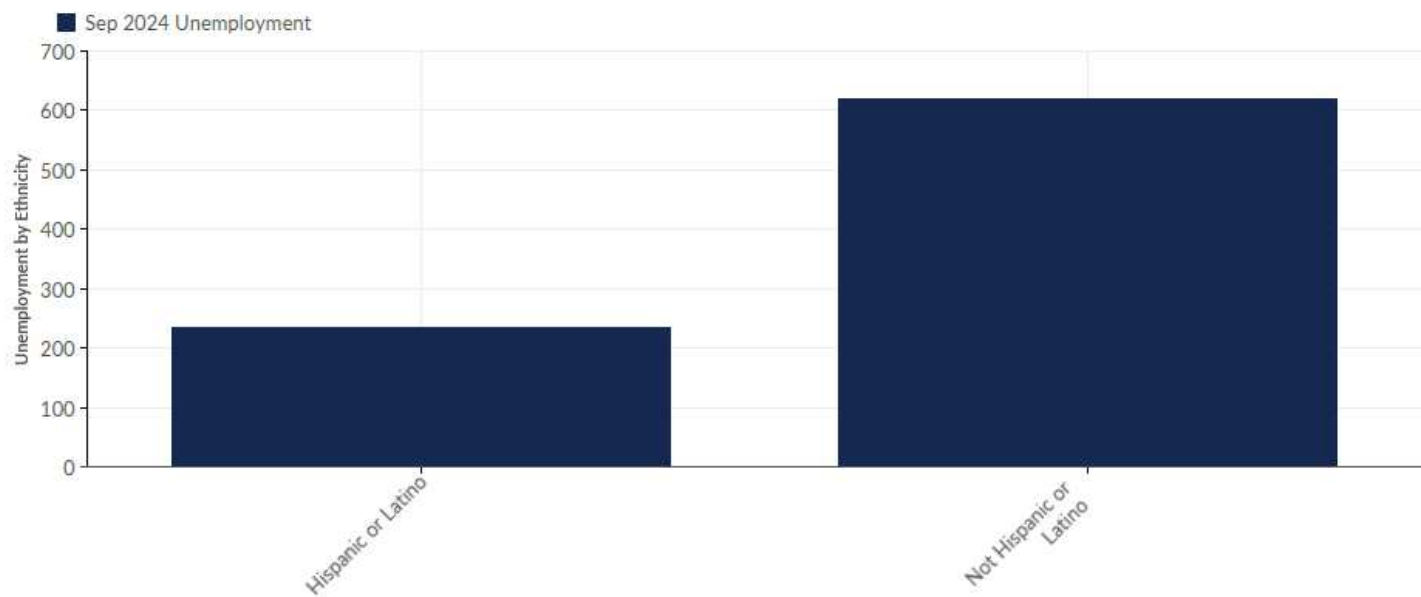

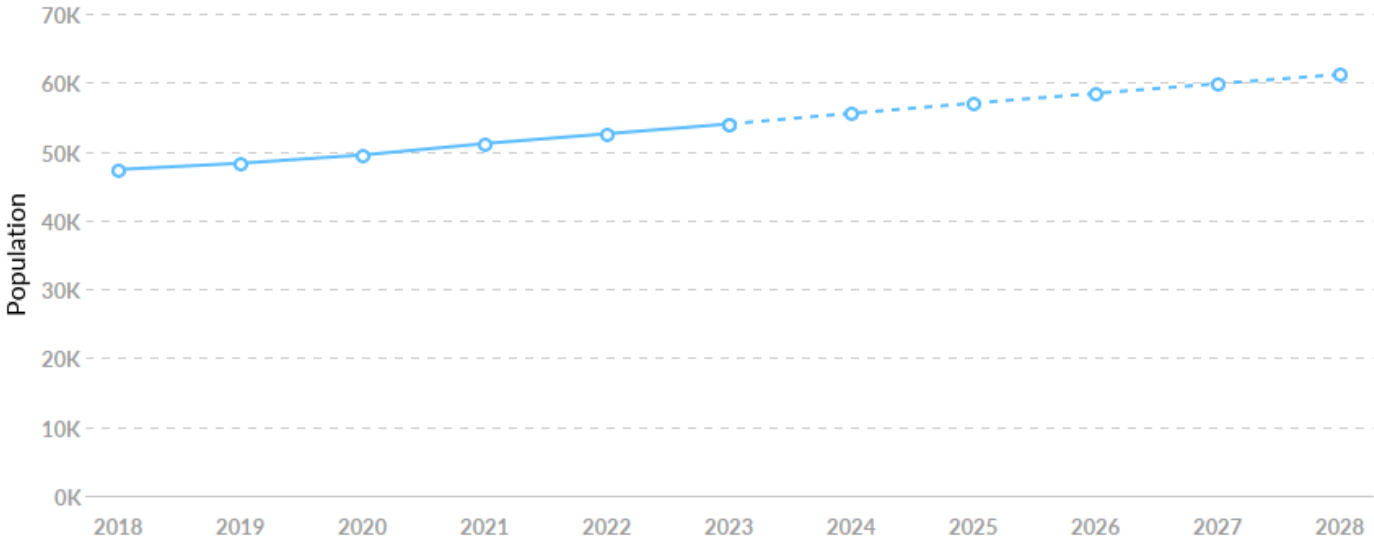

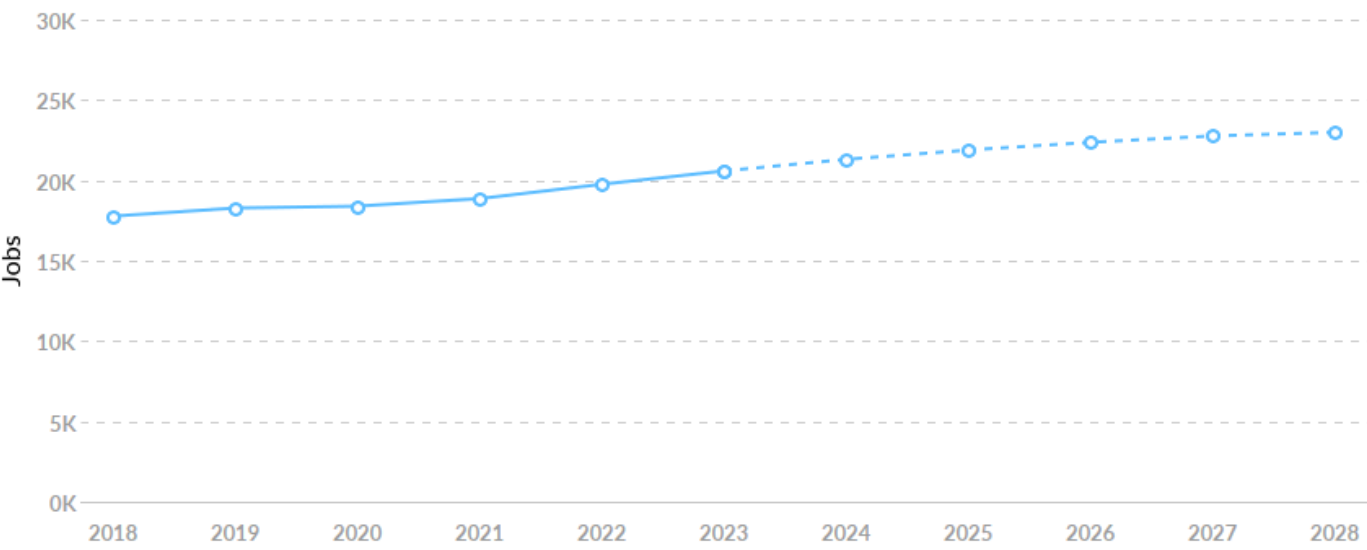

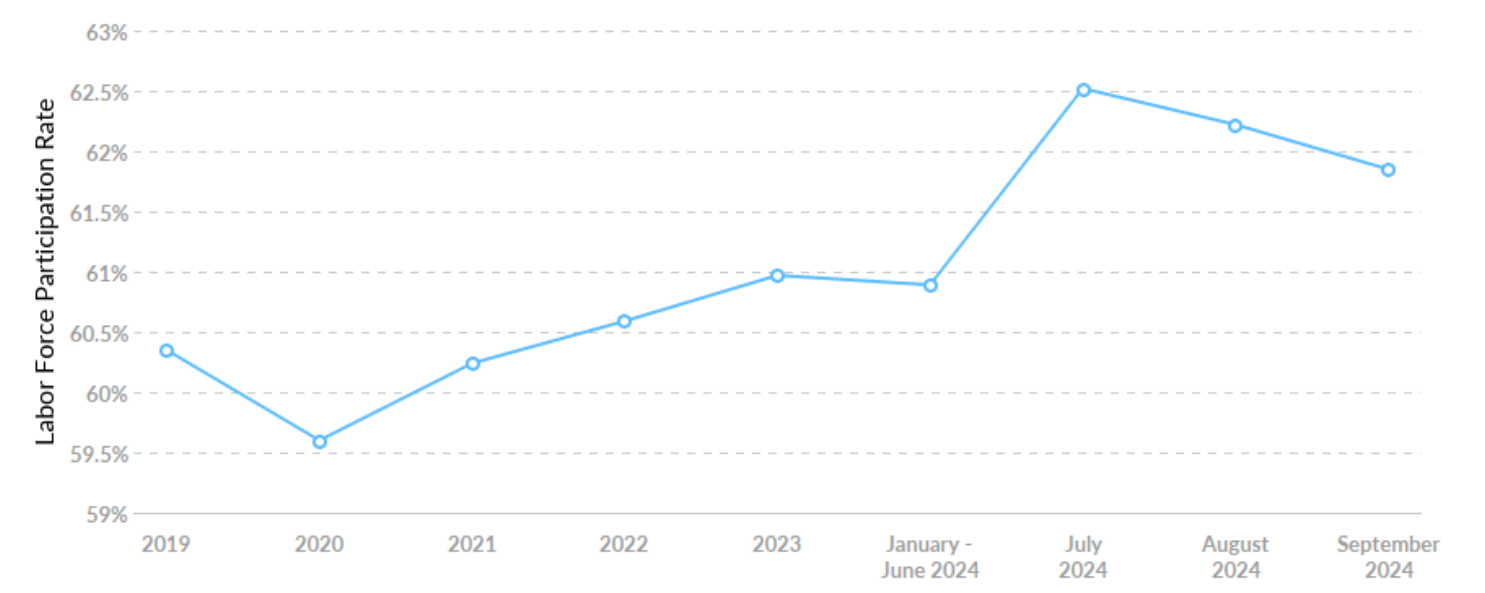
Job Trends

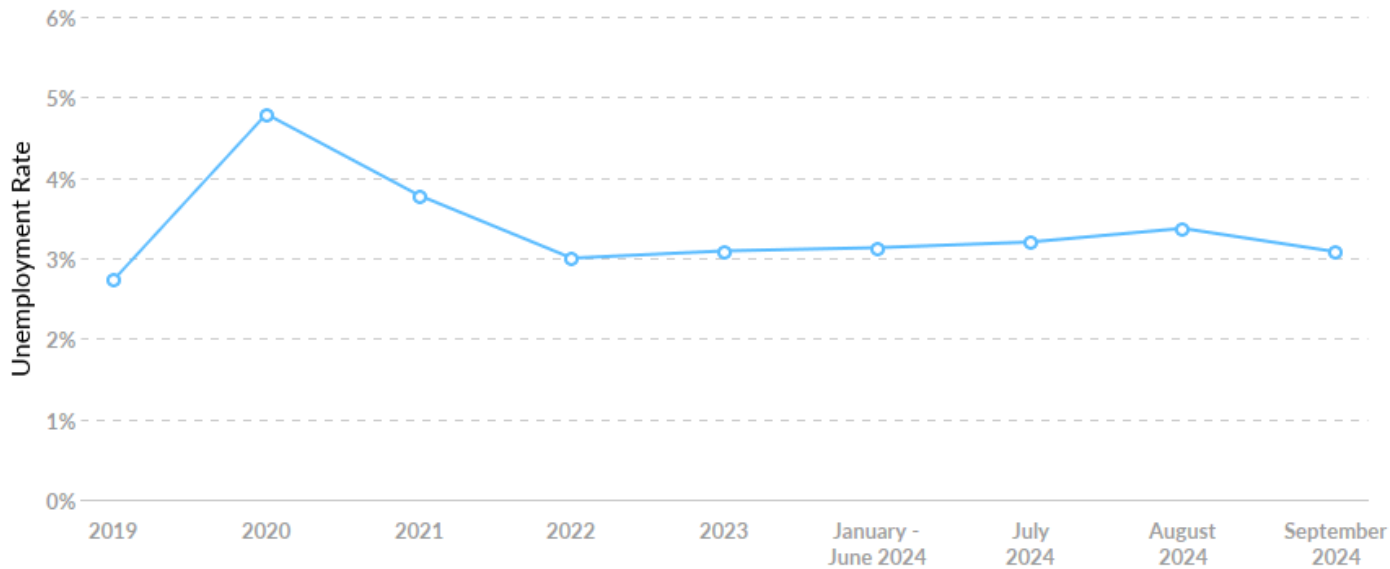

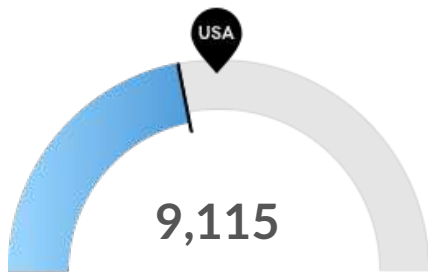
Unemployment Rate Trends

Burnet County, TX had a September 2024 unemployment rate of 3.08%, **increasing from 2.73%** 5 years before.



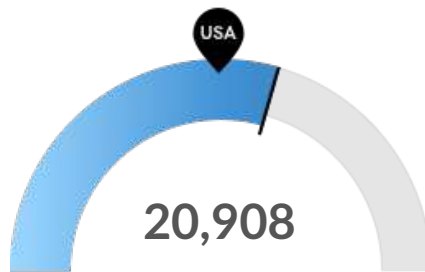

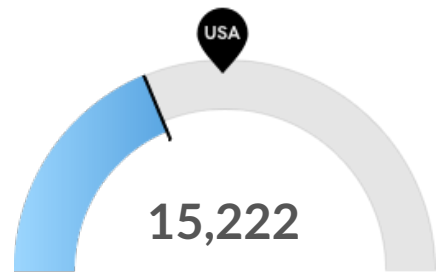
Millennials

Burnet County, TX has 9,115 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 10,970.



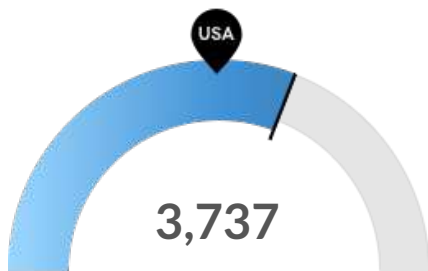
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Burnet County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 16,299 people 55 or older, while there are 20,908 here.



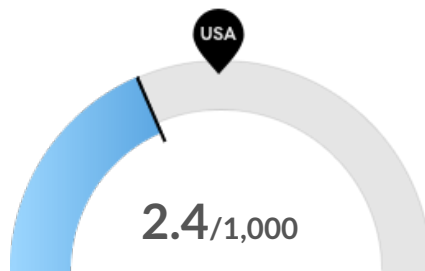
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Burnet County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 22,486 racially diverse people, while there are 15,222 here.



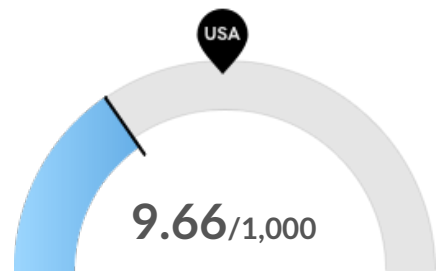
Veterans

Burnet County, TX has 2.4 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.6 per 1,000 people.

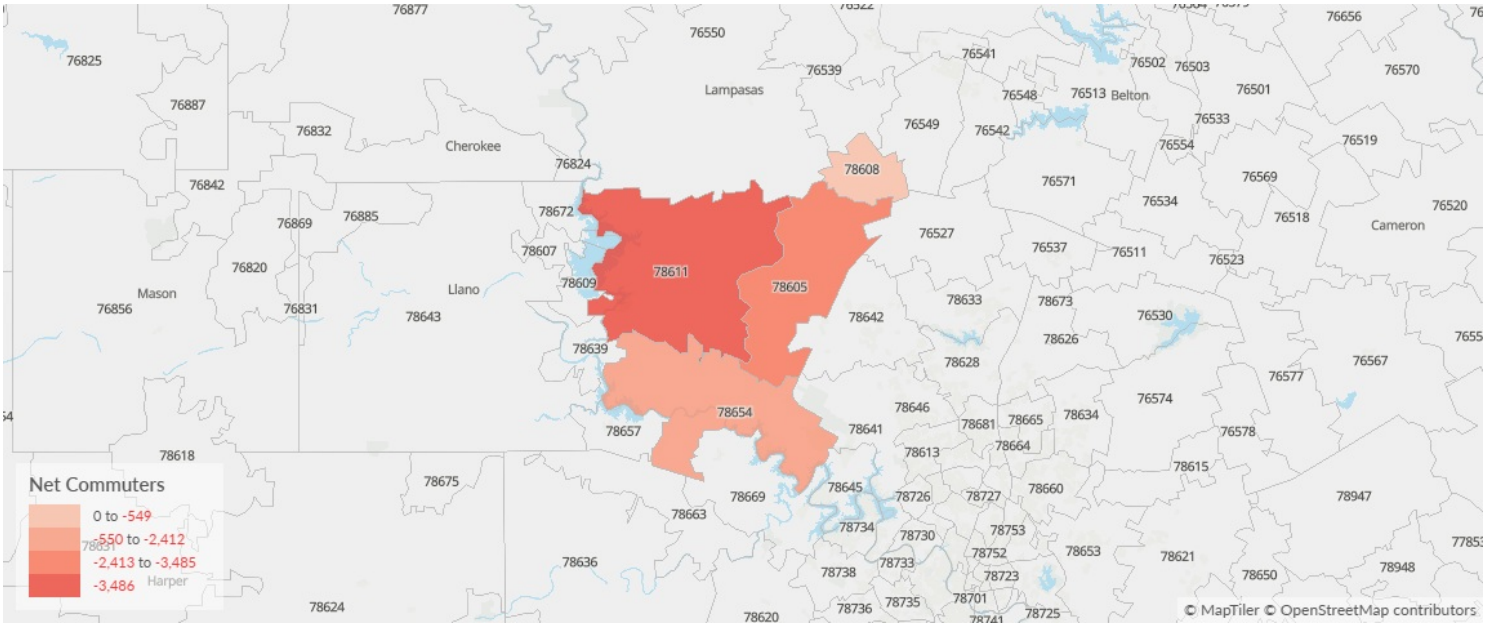


Property Crime

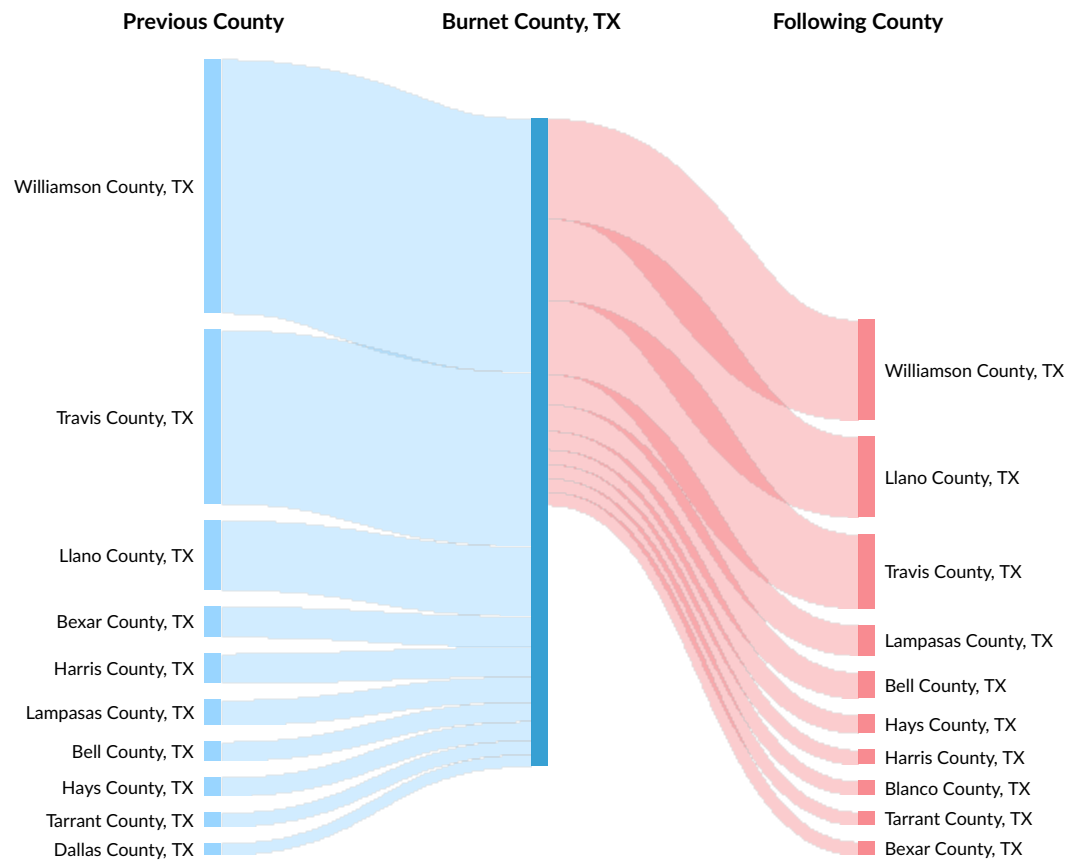

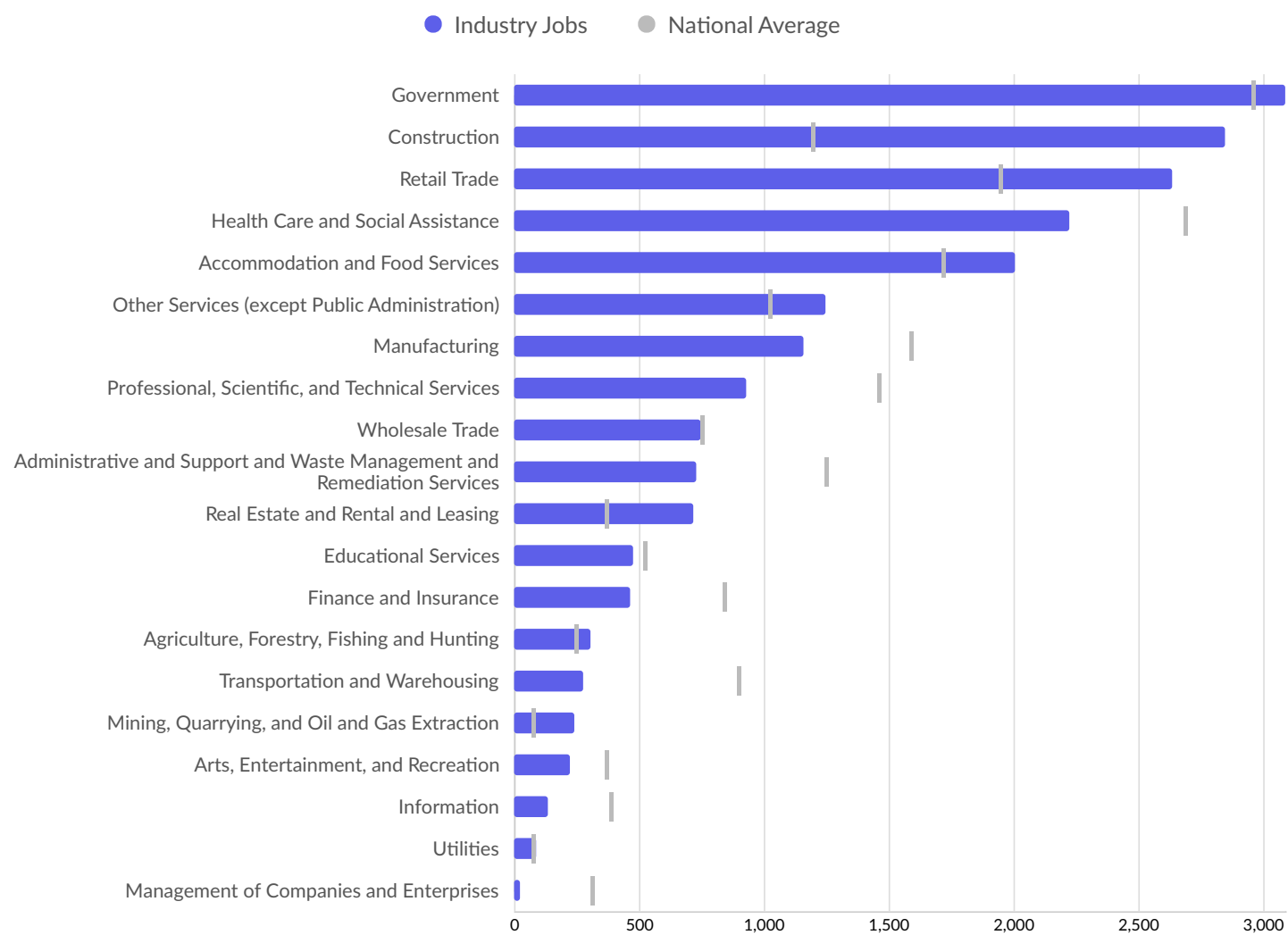

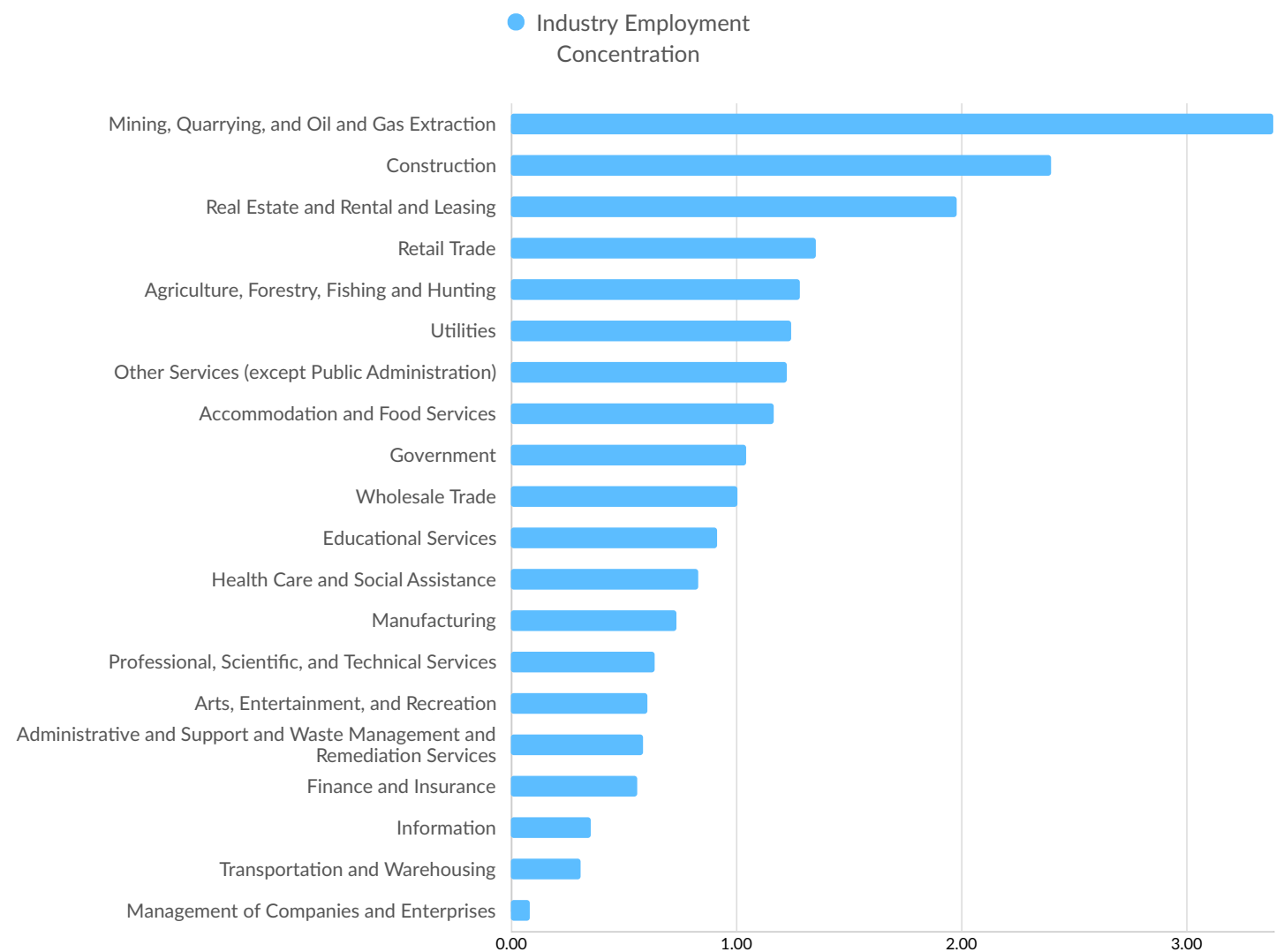

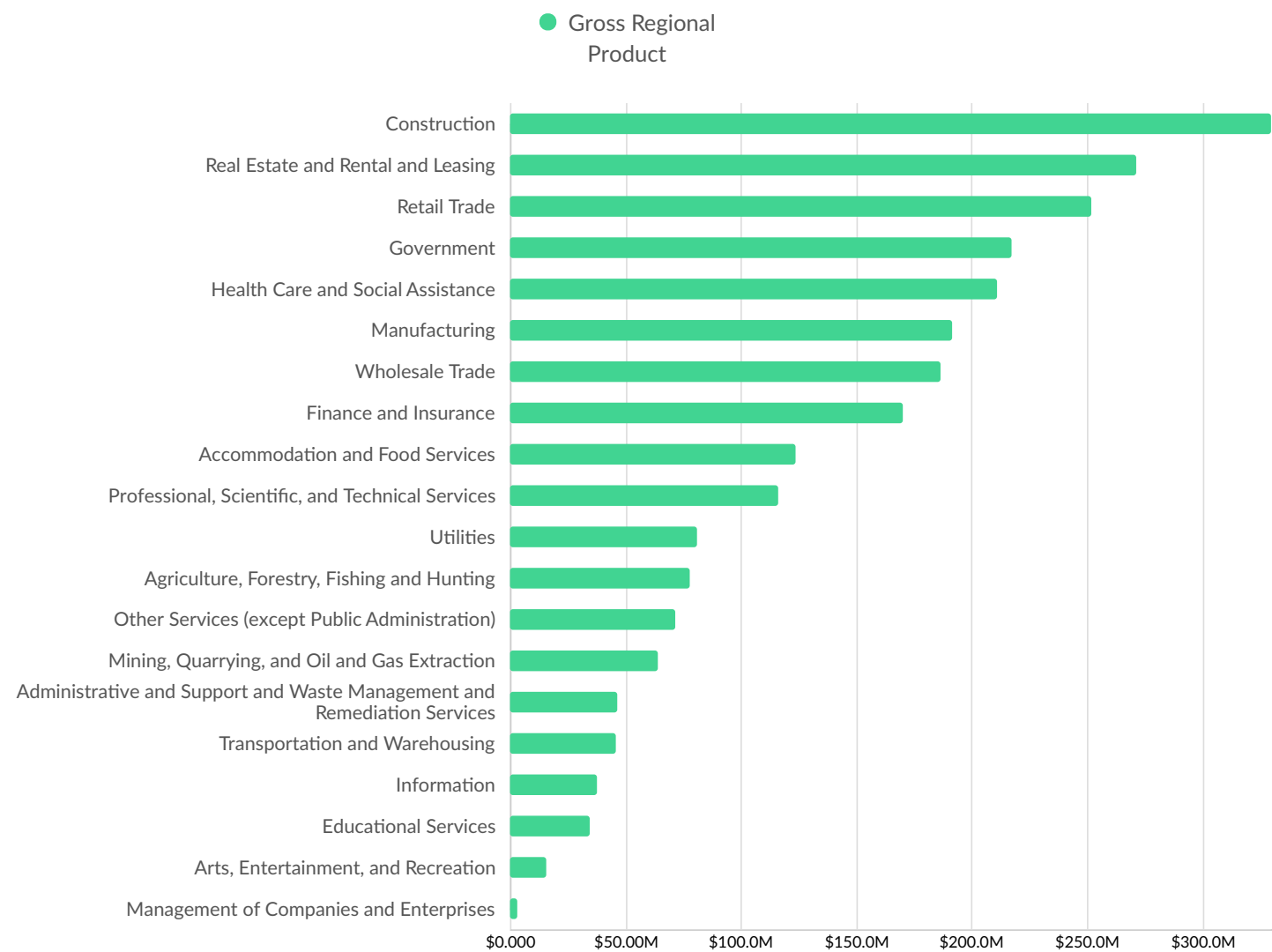
Top Growing Industries



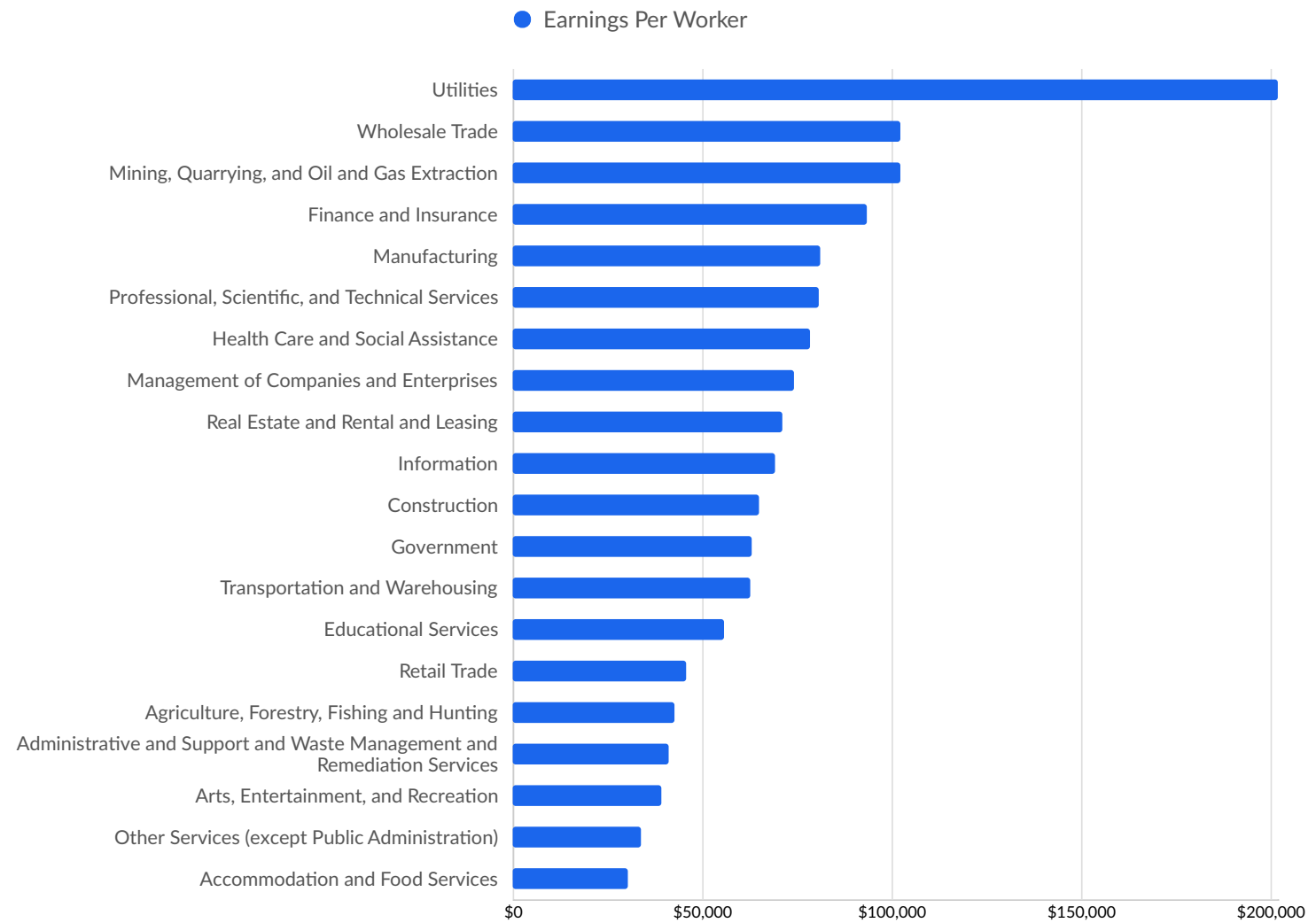
Top Industry Employment Concentration

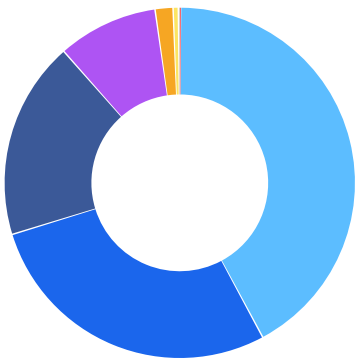

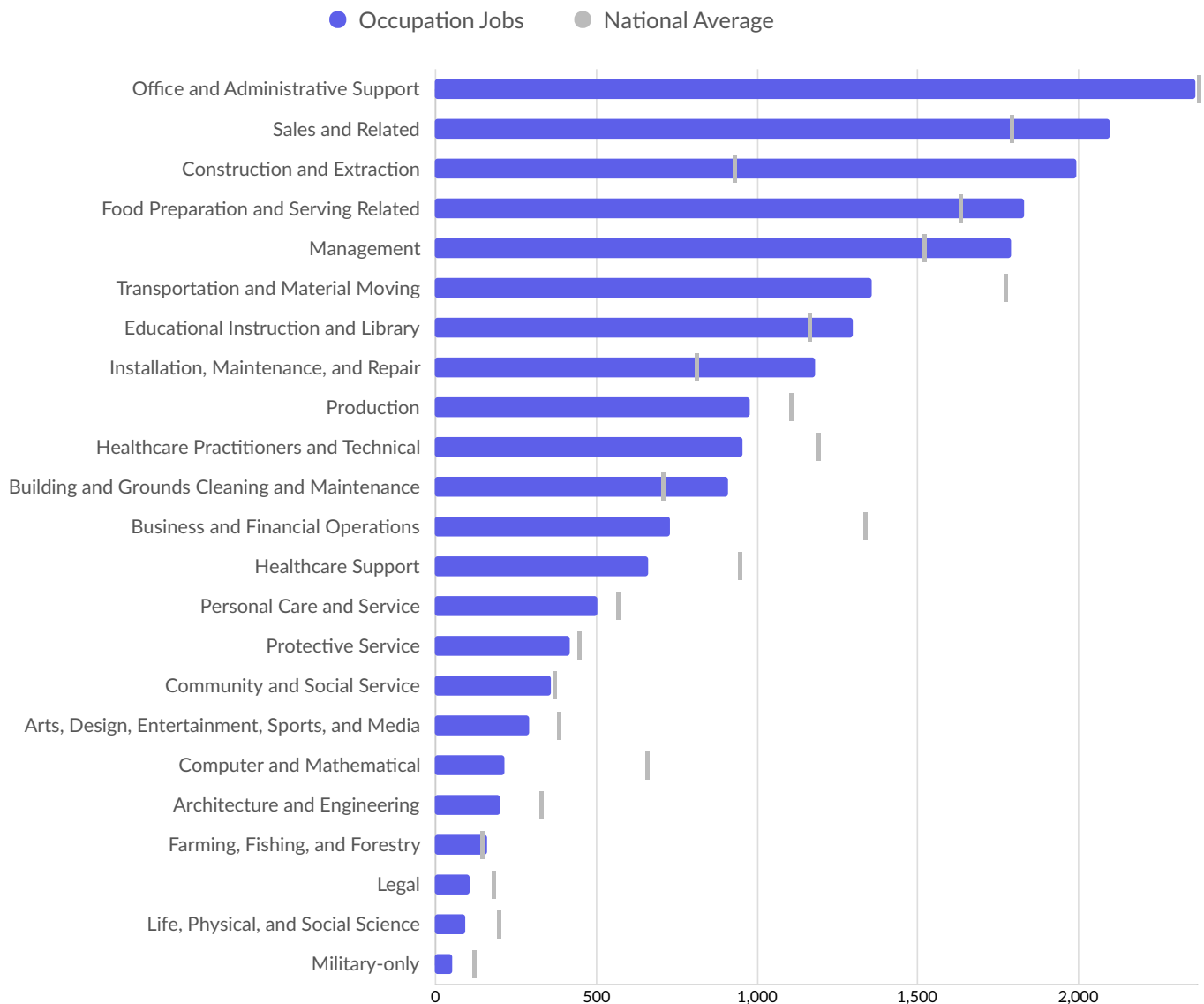

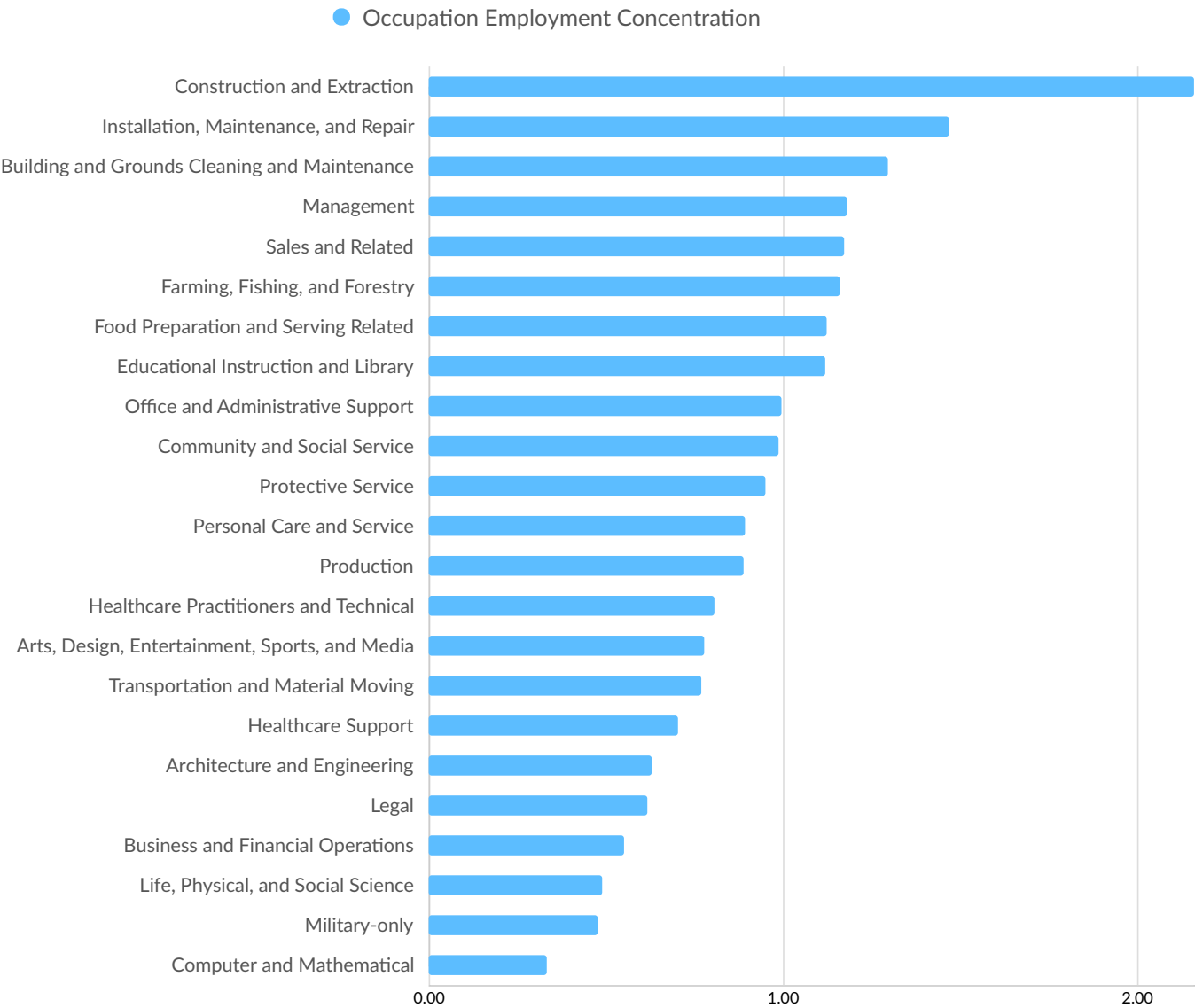

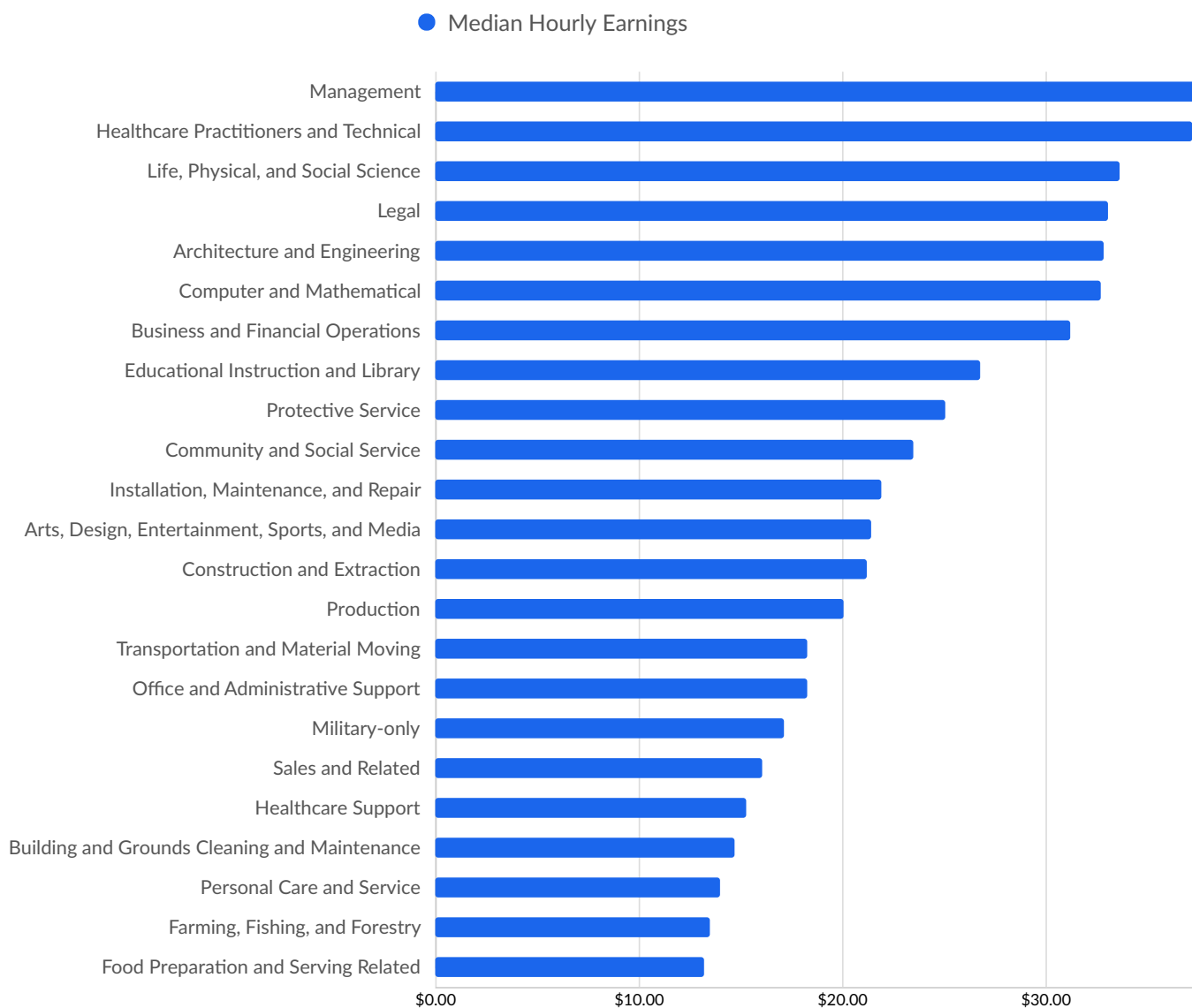
Top Growing Occupations



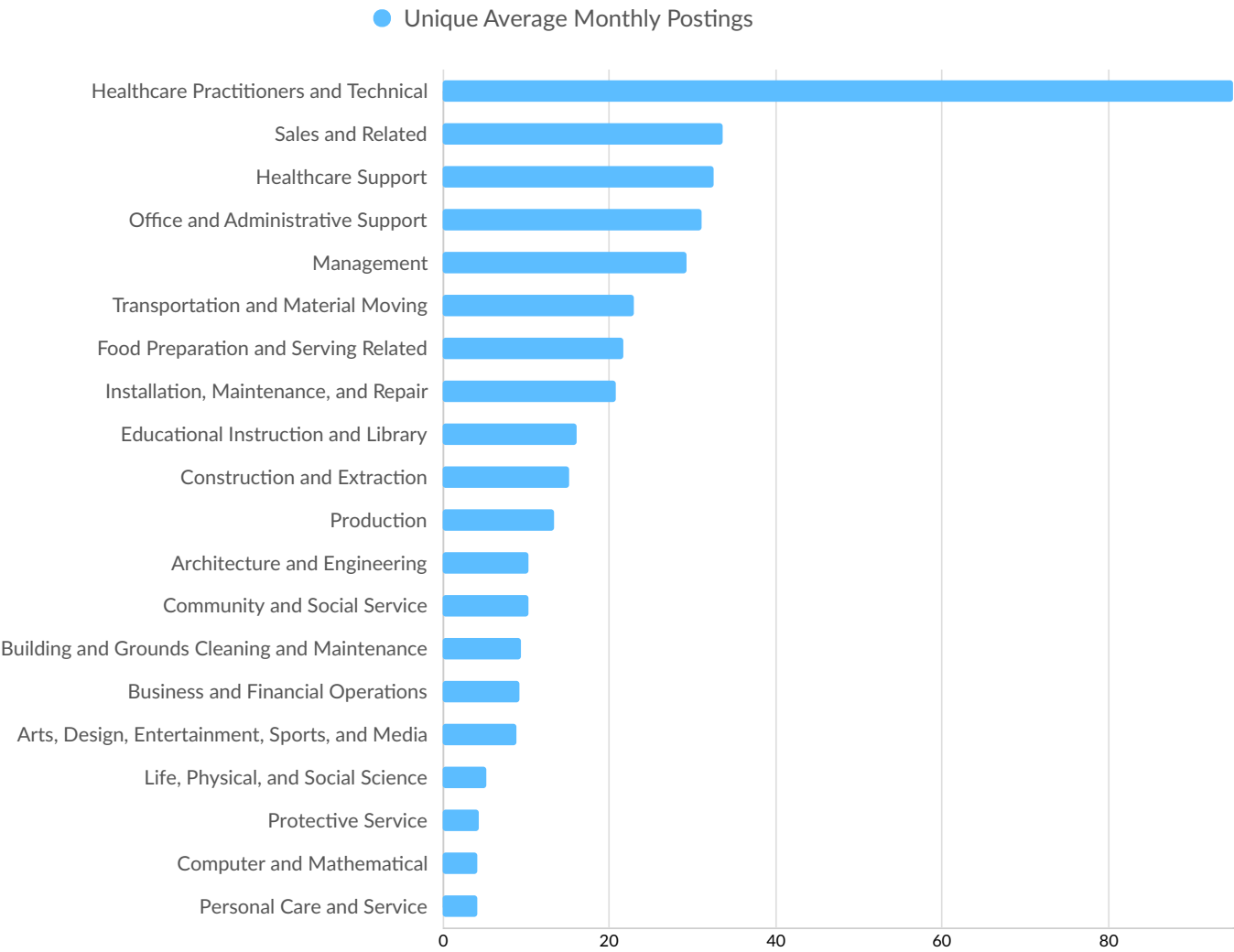
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



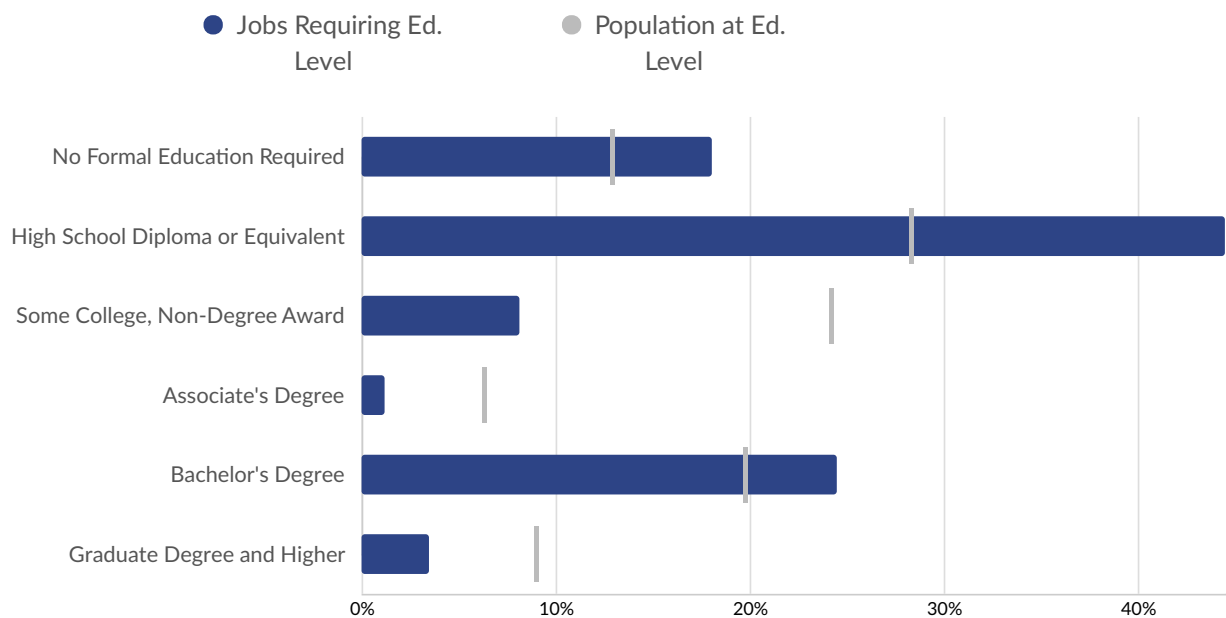
