





Unemployment by Gender








Population Trends






Unemployment Rate Trends

Caldwell County, TX had a September 2024 unemployment rate of 3.63%, increasing from 3.41% 5 years before.










Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration





Top Occupation Employment Concentration




