- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 25.8% since 2018, growing by 57,558. Population is expected to increase by 22.7% between 2023 and 2028, adding 63,542.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 28.8% in Hays County, TX from 81,209 to 104,559. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 4.5% by 24.3%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 64.5% to 64.6% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, 26.4% of Hays County, TX residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (5.2% above the national average), and 6.6% hold an Associate's Degree (2.3% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Education and Hospitals (State Government).
















Job Trends



Hays County, TX had a September 2024 unemployment rate of 3.42%, increasing from 2.79% 5 years before.






Millennials

Hays County, TX has 61,710 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 56,990.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is low in Hays County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 84,672 people 55 or older, while there are 62,131 here.




Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is high in Hays County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 116,814 racially diverse people, while there are 135,463 here.




Veterans

Hays County, TX has 3.07 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.6 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Occupation Employment Concentration



Top Occupation Earnings




Top Posted Occupations



Educational Pipeline

In 2023, there were 8,735 graduates in Hays County, TX. This pipeline has shrunk by 2% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from "Psychology, General" (Bachelor's), "Business Administration and Management, General" (Bachelor's), and "Exercise Science and Kinesiology" (Bachelor's).
