Setup New Account


1. Sign up

To setup a new account, click the "Sign Up" button on the homepage.



2. Enter your information


Enter the information requested on the next screen and pictured below. Use an email address you have access to (you'll receive an email to verify your account) and use a password that you will remember.




Make sure to check the "Agree to Terms" box before you click "Next".

3. Verify your email and login

The next page will alert you that you've been sent a verification email to activate your account, like the picture below. You will need to open the email you entered during signup before continuing.




Click the third link to verify your email address.



If you see the message below, you have successfully verified your email. Click "Login" to continue.




You can now use the email and password you created during signup to login. If you ever forget your password, you can click "Forgot Password?" to reset it.




4. Fill out the user profile

Choose your current title.




Add your zip code and choose in which area you want to search for jobs or education.

You can choose a single county, the Austin, TX Metro area, Rural Capital Area, or choose RCA +


Travis County to select the entire area.




Enter your age.




Select the highest level of education that you have already received.


Select as many career and education goals as you like. You can select all of them or one, but you must make one selection.

1. Filling out and adjusting the quiz


Use the settings box highlighted below to change your location, career interests, or intended education level.



Use the circle as a slider that moves left to right. Leaving it to the left signifies you have no interest or ability in that area. Moving it to the right means you do have interest or ability in that area.




A completed interests quiz might look like the one below.

2. Your top careers





Compare Careers




Learn about Top Careers


Find Education
